

WEDDING CEREMONY IN CHURCH

Steps to be taken to have a Church Wedding Ceremony:

1. If you choose to have your Church Wedding Ceremony in Faith Christian Centre Bandar Sunway, you will first have to register yourselves with the Registrar of Marriages.
2. It is a rule in the Sabah Anglican Diocese that a marriage can only be solemnized in Church if both persons to be married are baptized members of the Church.
3. Make an Appointment with the pastor as early as possible, preferably, one year before the planned date for wedding. Get a copy of the 'Marital Guidelines'. Confirm the date with the pastor to ensure the date is acceptable.
4. It is also compulsory for the couple to attend and complete a "The Marriage Preparation Course".
5. Get in touch with the pastor at least three months prior to the agreed wedding date to be introduced to the wedding assistant in the Church.

What other kind of help can be expected?

The following questions can be raised as you meet with the pastor:

1. What if my partner is not a believer?
2. What if our family members are not believers?
3. How do I finance my wedding?

The Marriage Preparation Course
